Soon I was promoted to become the navigating officer. The first year I never even thought of coming back home. I was busy fulfilling my desire to see the world and meeting different types of people and experiencing different kinds of cultures.

Restlessness and void set in fast. I was getting bored after five years of sailing. Novelty had worn off and my temperament too was not that of a sailor in most ways. I finally decided to say quits and join the family business which was waiting for me to return. My dad was overjoyed at my decision. I got married and soon become a father of two adorable children. My age at that time would have been early twenty four. Time flew by fast earning bread and butter for my family. Nothing was more important than bringing up the kids properly with a lots of love, something which I was deprived of during my childhood days.
